In 1983 a group of New Windsor citizens banded together and founded the New Windsor Heritage Committee (NWHC). Soon the NWHC became renowned for its house and garden tours, spirit walks, historical publications, oral history recordings, and Hall of Fame dinner. The NWHC also began working closely with the New Windsor Middle School, leading guided tours of the town for 6<sup>th</sup> graders and sponsoring archaeological digs at the old spring house and the Dielman Inn.

In 2006, we were fortunate to become a tenant in the property at 207 Main Street, courtesy of the New Windsor State Bank (NWSB). There we set up a museum where many artifacts and photos from the town's history are displayed for all to see. We now have an opportunity to buy the building and are asking you to help.

We are raising funds to both purchase 207 Main Street and make it ADA accessible. The NWSB has offered to match whatever we bring in dollar-for-dollar. Our goal is \$100,000, and through the generosity of our members we are almost half-way there. With the funds raised we will:

- Purchase the building
- Install an ADA accessible bathroom and water fountain
- Modify an entrance for ADA compliance
- Protect our collection with UV window film
- Create a building maintenance fund
- Work with educators to create a local history curriculum
- Continue financial support for middle school archaeological digs
